## 5. AGREEMENTS FOR RESEARCH COLLABORATION

- e. Other provisions as may be mutually agreed upon, including provisions covering the consequences of default or termination by a participant, term, arbitration of disputes and applicable law.

### 6. CONFIDENTIALITY

- a. During and for a period of three years from the date of disclosure, each party agrees to consider as confidential all information disclosed by the other party in written or tangible form or, if orally disclosed confirmed in writing within thirty days of disclosure and identified as confidential by the disclosing party.

## 7. NON-EXCLUSIVITY

The receiving party shall not, directly or indirectly, disclose to any third party other than its employees, affiliated companies, and authorized agents any information concerning the disclosing party's business methods, products, customers or finances, or any other Confidential Information which is disclosed to it by the disclosing party, without the prior written permission of the disclosing party, unless such disclosure is specifically required in the course of the performance by the receiving party of its obligations hereunder or under the resultant definitive agreements. The obligations of receiving party under this Section shall not extend to any information which: (i) is or becomes a matter of public knowledge, not as a result of any action of the receiving party; (ii) is lawfully in the possession of the receiving

The two arbitrators shall then appoint a third arbitrator before entering upon the reference. The Arbitration proceedings shall be regulated by the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 and the venue of the arbitration shall be Bangalore, India. The language of Arbitration shall be English. The arbitrators may from time to time with the written consent of Parties enlarge the time for making and
