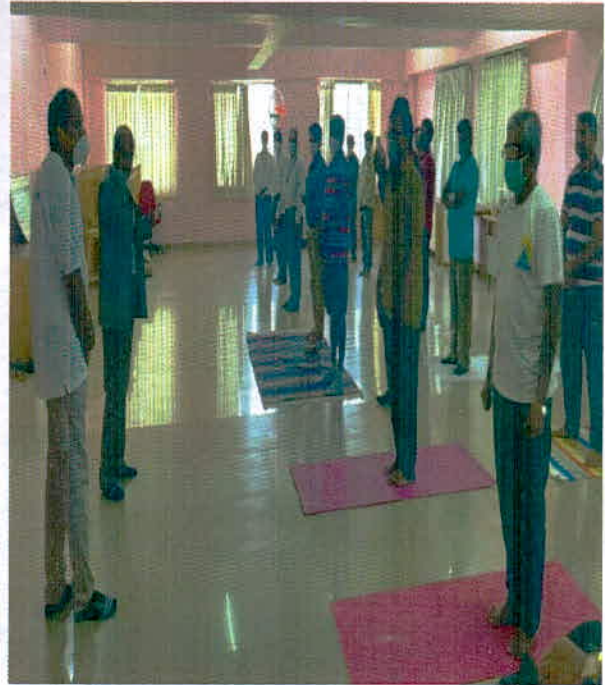

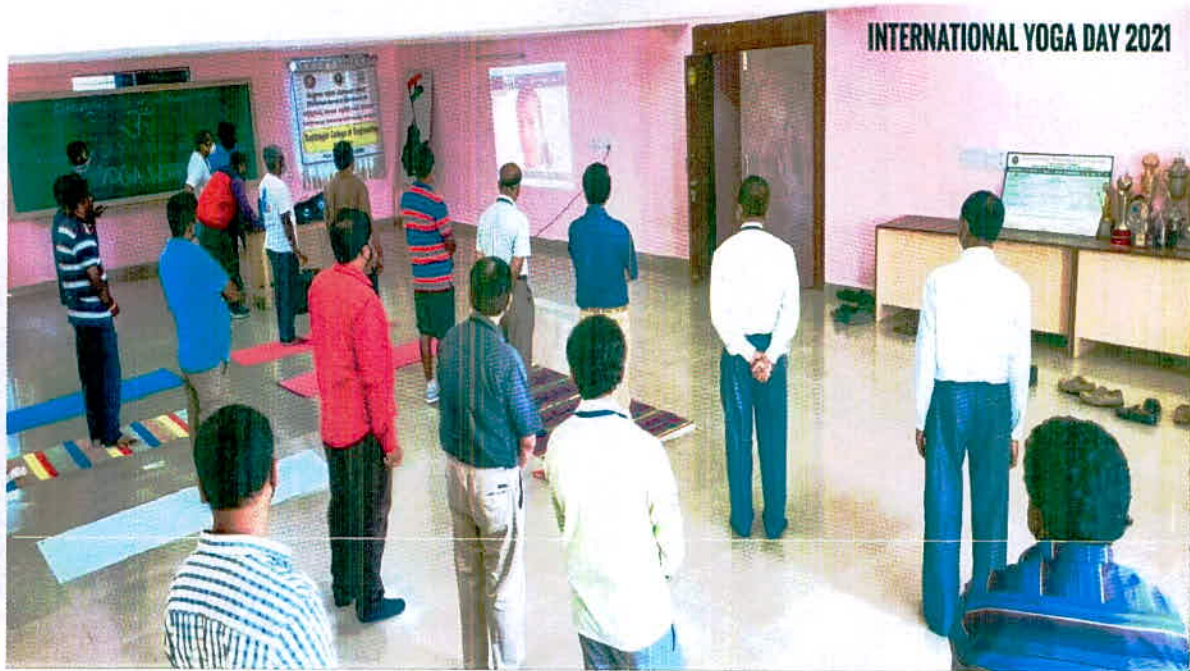

## **World No Tobacco Day 2021**

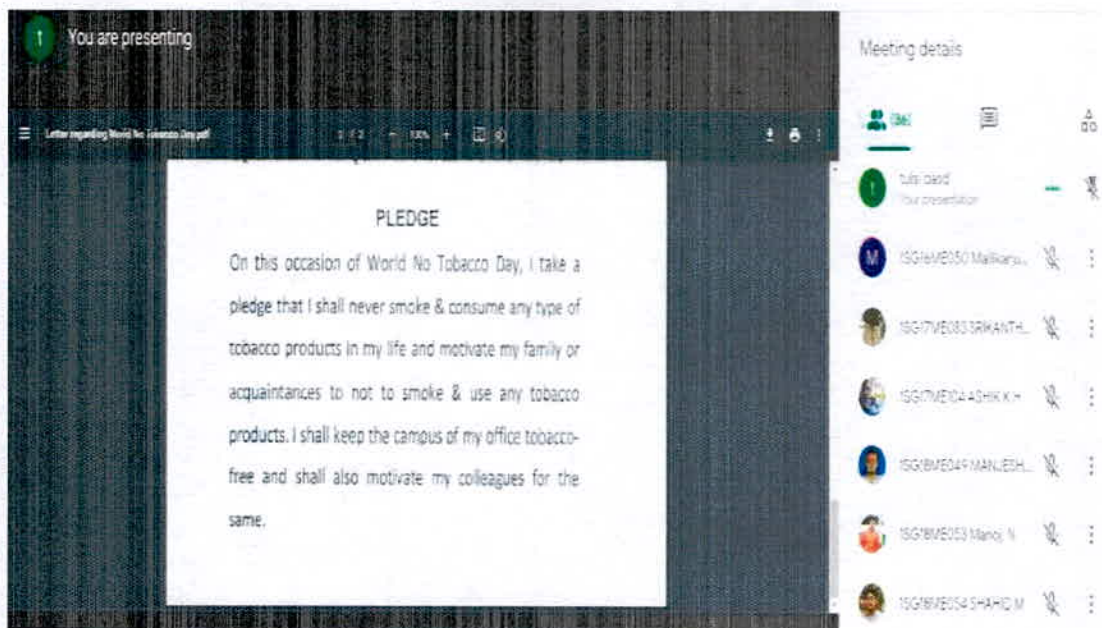

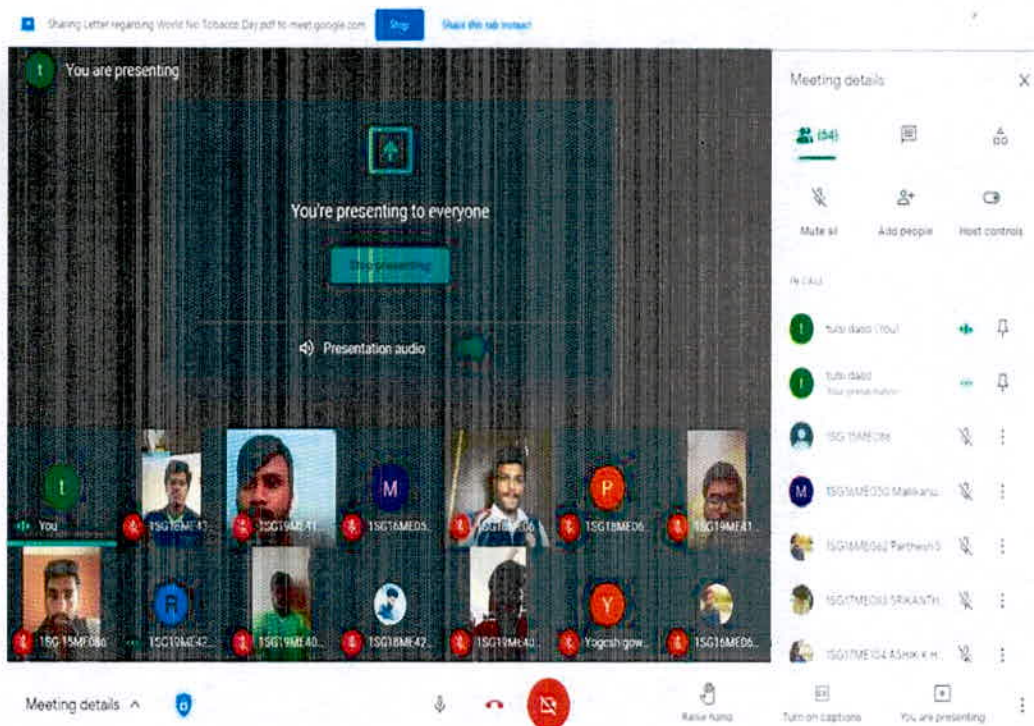

### VOTER'S PLEDGE

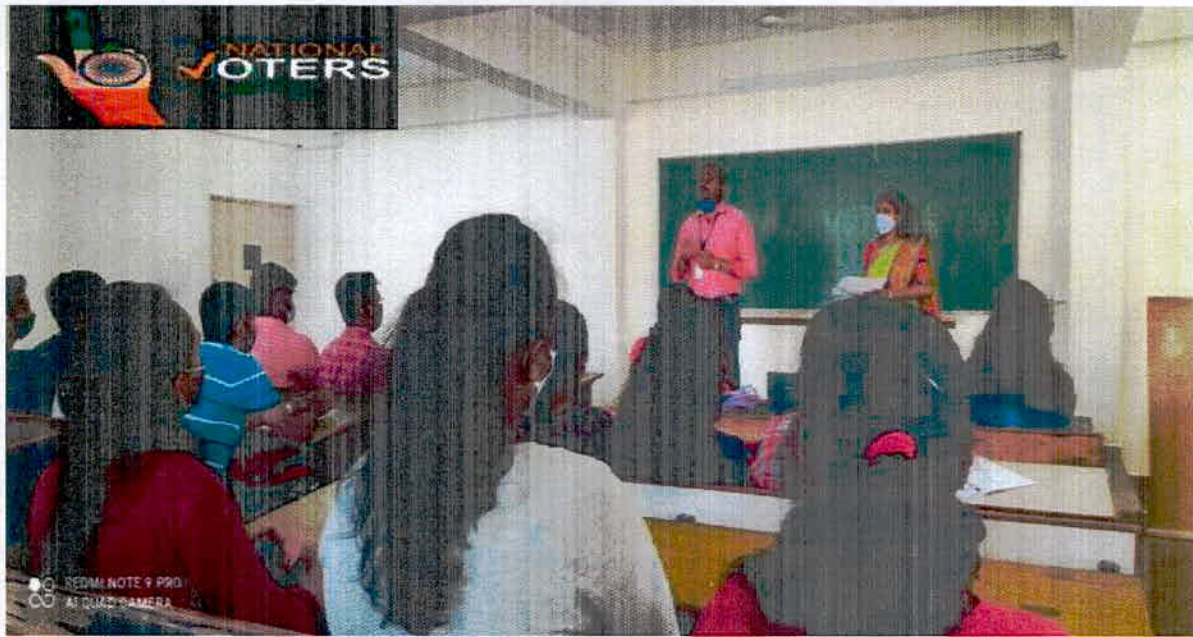

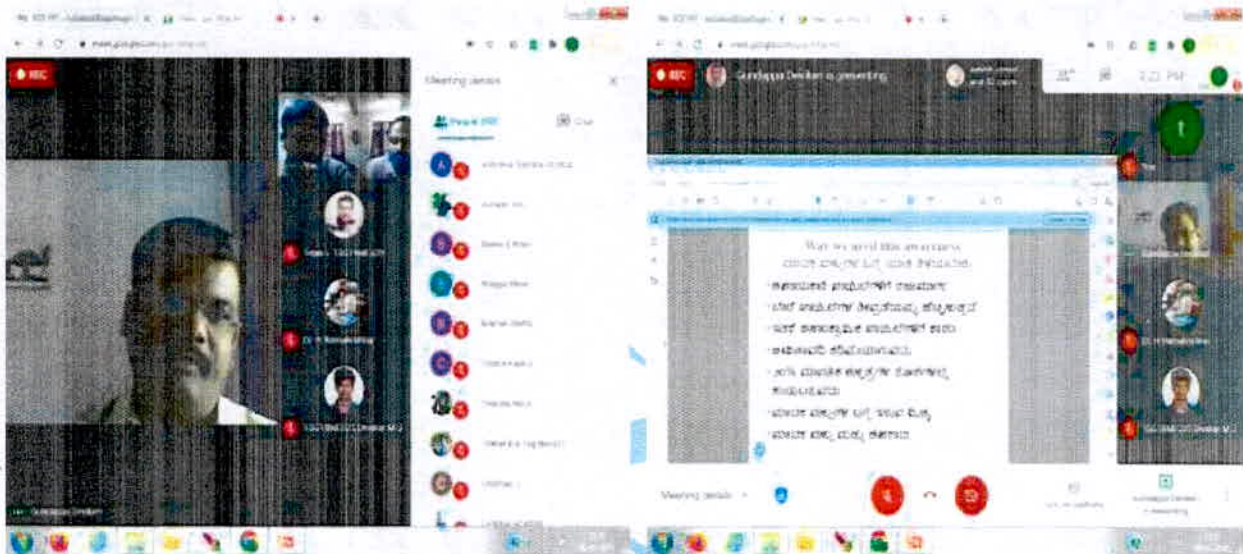
