Sadbhavana Diwas is observed with optimism and warmth throughout the country.


On this day, citizens around the country make the following pledge:


Importance of Sadbhavana Diwas



Constitution Day (SAMVIDHANA Divasa), also known as "National Law Day", is celebrated in India on 26 November every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. On 26 November 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted to the Constitution of India, and it came into effect on 26 January 1950.


The Government of India declared 26 November as Constitution Day on 19 November 2015 by a gazette notification. The Prime Minister of India Narendra Modi made the declaration on 11 October 2015 while laying the foundation stone of the B. R. Ambedkar's Statue of Equality memorial in Mumbai. The year of 2021 was the 131st birth anniversary of Ambedkar, who had chaired the drafting committee of the Constituent Assembly and played a pivotal role in the drafting of the constitution. Previously this day was celebrated as Law Day. 26 November was chosen to spread the importance of the constitution and to spread thoughts and ideas of Dr.B.R.Ambedkar.

NSS program officer Dr.Tulsidas D has organized a programme of "Constitution day" on 27-11-2023 Monday. The programme held in various class rooms at SCE. The faculties gave a glimpse on constitution day. The programme convener has preached the preamble of the constitution to all the students. Students were read the preamble. 
Awareness on Indian Constitution






Drug Awareness Program


