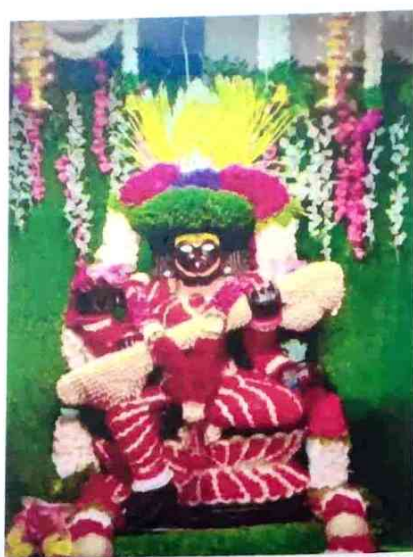

Cultural committee organized the following events for the AY: 2023-24

1. Navaratri Pooja-2023:

An important Hindu festival, Navratri is a celebration of the divine feminine power that is precious to millions of people in India and around the world. Nine Nights, or "Navratri," is celebrated with great fervor and enthusiasm. This festival honors goddess Durga and all of her manifestations, which represent distinct aspects of feminine power and divinity. The festival celebrates the triumph of good over evil, symbolizing the demise of ignorance and ego-serving demon Mahishasura and the victory of the goddess Durga over him.

Sapthagiri College Of Engineering has its own tradition of celebrating Navaratri in a well versed manner. As per the discussions and meetings of Cultural Committee, the Nine days from 15th October 2023- 24th October 2023 was distributed to each department. Every day the event was well organized with the efforts of cultural coordinators and the students of corresponding departments. The pooja was performed according to the Vedashastra and with Kalasha sthapana and Praana prathishtapana. The prasadam was distributed to all the members of SCE on each day during afternoon. The Dasara festival was executed with immense joy and coordination among all involved.



2 Hombelakku-2023 :

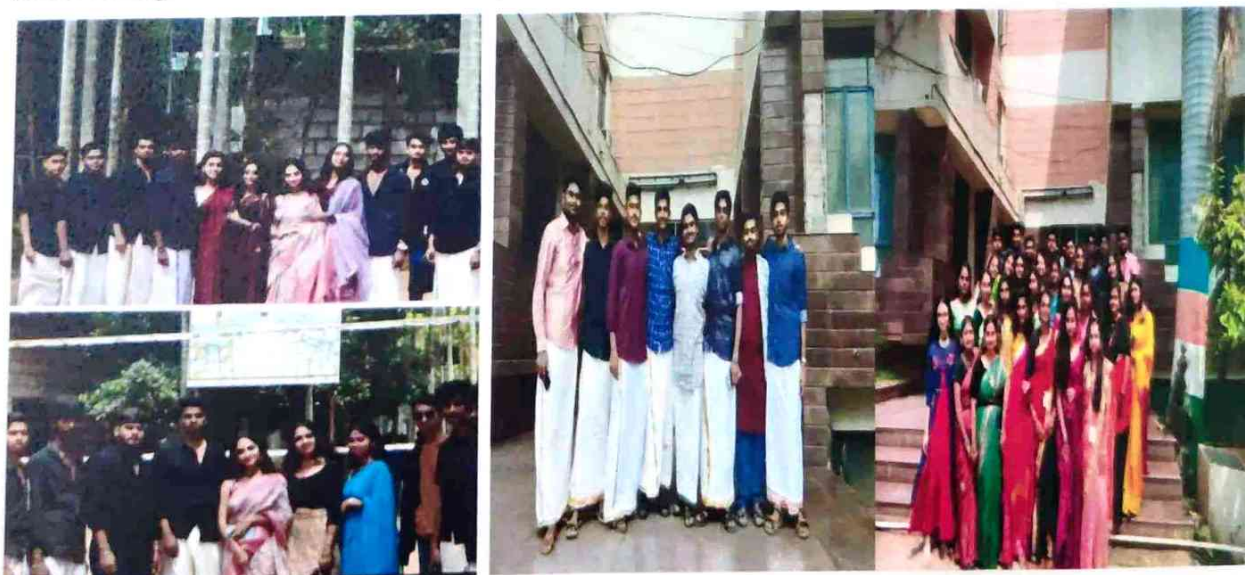
The following events come under Okuli- 2023:

The following events come under Chanakya 2023:

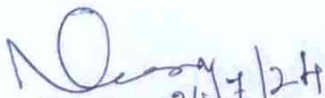
