## MEMORUNDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



This Memorandum of Understanding is entered at Bangalore on this, 9<sup>th</sup> Day of January (09/01/2019) in the Year 2019.

### **BETWEEN**

**Master i2R Solutions** represented by its Sales Director Mr. Kumar Ramaiah having its Registered Office at No 20, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Magadi Main Road, Opp Agrahara Dasarahalli Bus Stop, Vijayanagar, Bengaluru, Karnataka – 560079, hereinafter referred to as “**MASTER i2R SOLUTIONS**” or the **FIRST PARTY**;

### **AND**

**Sapthagiri College of Engineering** having its premises at 14/5, Hesarghatta Main Rd, Chikkasandra, Jallahalli West, Bengaluru, Karnataka 560057, India, here in after referred to as-“**Sapthagiri College of Engineering - Computer Science Department**” or the **SECOND PARTY**.

(Hereinafter - **MASTER i2R SOLUTIONS** AND **Sapthagiri College of Engineering - Computer Science Department** shall be individually referred to as Party and jointly as Parties shall).

### **WHEREAS**

- The First Party, a Skill Development Company having expertise in Professional and Industrial Education and is an Approved Learning Provider of TCS iON content, developed by MASTER i2R SOLUTIONS in association with TCS iON
- The Second Party on its part is interested in associating with First Party for using their expertise to promote and deliver the technical Internship, Project Work and any technical program driving innovation as a graduate Program of **Sapthagiri College of Engineering - Computer Science Department**
- The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is to set forth the terms and conditions under which the Parties to this understanding shall conduct themselves during the subsistence of the Memorandum





- Both parties as above have expressed a desire of entering a Memorandum of Understanding with **Sapthagiri College of Engineering - Computer Science Department** to meet their objectives
- This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is not intended to be legally binding except as specifically set out below
- The Second Party shall provide the necessary support to the First Party to deliver the training on the agreed subject's / Programs through VIGAMA
- Students who register for the program avails the facility of the first party & Second party, to learn the stated subject and do the project in the chosen field of interest
- The First Party can use the name of the **Sapthagiri College of Engineering** for promoting the programs in advertisements and other modes of communications
- The admission criteria and the number of seats for the respective programs are fixed by the Second Party in consultation with First Party
- The First Party provides electronic copy of relevant learning materials to the students enrolled for the respective programs
- All responsibilities regarding registration of the students should be dealt by the First Party.
- The fees towards the program must be paid by the students to either of the Parties with respect to the program enrolled by the students
- Out of the Tuition Fees Collected, the students must make the necessary payment to the First Party as per the agrees payment terms
- The complete list of students of the course shall be provided to the First Party by the Second Party. Changes in students, if any, shall be communicated by the representative of the Second Party to the First Party immediately without any delay
- It is intended that the terms of this MoU will remain in force for an initial period of (3) three years from the date of agreement and shall be valid until the termination or expiration, whichever is earlier of this MOU



- The MoU can be extended for further periods after the expiry of (3) three years upon the parties mutually agreeing such extension in writing. The terms of this Memorandum may be modified at any time by both Parties on mutual consent
- Either party shall be entitled to terminate the MOU on 60 days' prior written notice. The MoU will automatically terminate:
  - If either party becomes insolvent or is subject to a change of control;
  - If this MOU /transaction /business is unenforceable, void or illegal due to any statutory or regulatory requirements.
- All intellectual property created by a party in connection with the Collaboration shall remain the property of that party. The Parties agree that any material jointly created by the Parties for the collaboration shall be jointly owned (in equal proportions) by the parties, unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- Where the collaboration reasonably requires the use by one party of intellectual property that is owned by the other party (the "**IPR Owner**"), the IPR Owner will license such rights to the other party on a non-exclusive basis, without the right to sub-license, solely for the purpose and to the extent necessary in connection with the collaboration under this MOU and/or subsequent binding agreement. Any such license will automatically terminate when the MoU is terminated.
- For the purposes of this MoU, "**Confidential Information**" shall be confidential in nature (whether written, visual or oral) concerning the business and affairs of either party which is obtained or received as a result of the discussions leading up to, the entering into or the performance of this MoU, including financial information, training & learning material, trade secrets, college lists, trade and commercial details and computer software and databases, the contents of all reports and documentation prepared by either party or on its behalf and any other information of a confidential nature designated by a party as confidential;
- Each of the parties shall always abide, while this MoU remains in force and after it has been terminated, keep confidential Information except where:
- The Confidential Information was already lawfully known, or became lawfully known to either of the parties independently;





- Disclosure or use is necessary by either of the parties (including their employees, agents and sub-contractors) for the proper and effective performance of this MoU;
- Disclosure is required by law to any government, governmental department, agency, regulatory or fiscal body or authority (whether national or foreign) and their authorized agents (including professional advisers);
- The Confidential Information is disclosed, in the case of MASTER i2R SOLUTIONS, to another member of the MASTER i2R SOLUTIONS group of companies;
- All disputes and differences of any kind whatever arising out of or in connection with this MoU shall be referred to the arbitration, and the final decision of an arbitrator jointly appointed by both the Parties to be agreed upon and appointed by both the parties. This submission to the arbitrators shall be deemed to be a submission to arbitration within the meaning of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, or any statutory modification thereof. The award of the arbitrator or arbitrators shall be final and binding on the parties.
- In case of any disputes not settled due to arbitration it will be subject to the courts of Bangalore Jurisdiction. The laws of India shall be applicable.

## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

### **1. OBJECTIVES OF THE MOU**

The objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is:

- a. In their own existing facilities - The performance of research individually by each Party or concurrently by both Parties in mixed groups at their own facilities with regular exchanges of results.

- c. **Third parties** - The performance of research by the Parties together with one or more third parties.

#### **4. TECHNICAL AREAS OF COLLABORATION**

The principal technical areas of collaboration between SCE and ACRANTON TECHNOLOGIES PVT. LTD. will be as set out in Annexure A.


#### **5. AGREEMENTS FOR RESEARCH COLLABORATION**

Each research collaboration undertaken by the parties hereunder shall be initiated by the signing of a separate research agreement between the parties, which will describe in detail:

- a. The nature, scope and schedule of the research collaboration.
- b. The form of the research collaboration.
- c. The estimated cost of the research collaboration together with the amount of funding, if any, to be received from third parties.
- d. The treatment of intellectual property and data rights, including patents, industrial design registration, copyrights and all other proprietary information (including innovations not patented, designs not registered etc.) which result from the research collaboration or which belong to a party and are used in research collaboration.
- e. Other provisions as may be mutually agreed upon, including provisions covering the consequences of default or termination by a participant, term, arbitration of disputes and applicable law.

#### **6. CONFIDENTIALITY**

- a. During and for a period of three years from the date of disclosure, each party agrees to consider as confidential all information disclosed by the other party in written or tangible form or, if orally disclosed confirmed in writing within thirty days of disclosure and identified as confidential by the disclosing party.
- b. The obligations above shall not extend to any confidential information for which the receiving party can prove that this information:

- Is in the public domain at the time of disclosure or comes within the public domain without fault of the receiving party.
- Is already known or become known to the receiving party
- Is received from a third party having no obligations of confidentiality to the disclosing party,
- Is independently developed by the receiving party; or
- Is required to be disclosed by law or court order.

## 7. NON-EXCLUSIVITY

The relationship of the parties under this MOU shall be nonexclusive and both parties, including their affiliates, subsidiaries and divisions, are free to pursue other agreements or collaborations of any kind. However, when entering into a particular research agreement, the participants may agree to limit each party's right to collaborate with others on that subject.

## 8. TERMS AND TERMINATION

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written agreement of the parties, shall expire - **THREE** years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. This MOU may be amended or terminated earlier by mutual written agreement of the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MOU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other party. However, no such early termination of this MOU, whether mutual or unilateral, shall affect the obligations of the participants under any Research Agreement, Confidentiality clause as referenced in clause 6 above, or any other agreement entered in pursuant to this MOU, which obligations shall survive any such termination.






## 9. Duration, Amendment and Termination of MoU




## 9. Duration, Amendment and Termination of MoU

## Memorandum of Understanding

NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE AND AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

4. 6. Both parties hereby agree to designate a representative from its side who will be the primary point of contact on behalf of that party.
7. Any expenses incurred by the parties for the purpose of this MOU shall be agreed upon and shall be borne as per the mutual agreement.
8. Notwithstanding any other provision of this MOU, neither party shall have any right to use any trademarks or trade name of the other party, nor to refer to this MOU or the obligations performed hereunder directly or indirectly, in connection with any product, promotion, or publication without the prior written approval of the other party.
9. All information which has been disclosed to or obtained by either party at any time during the implementation of this MOU, is confidential information. For this purpose the parties agree to sign the binding non-disclosure agreement in Annexure II.



10. The terms and conditions mentioned herein shall commence on the execution of this MOU and shall continue for a period of two (2) years from the date thereof or for such period as may be determined or extended by the parties from time to time by written notice, unless terminated by either party in accordance with this MOU. Either party may terminate this MOU at any time by providing three (3) months written notice to the other party.
11. Any notice required to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed to be sufficiently served on the party if sent by hand or by registered post to the addresses of the party as stated in this MOU. Notices shall be deemed received:-
  - (i) If sent by registered mail, three (3) days after posting.
  - (ii) If by hand, on the day of delivery; and
  - (iii) If sent by telex or facsimile to the correct number or designated address within seventy-two (72) working hours.
12. Both parties agree to take all reasonable steps to ensure the successful completion of the collaboration, and co-operate with each other in duly carrying out the obligation agreed upon.
13. The expiration and termination of this MOU will not affect the terms of those activities, which are in progress at the time of notification of expiry or termination of the MOU.
14. On the termination or expiry of this MOU or when requested by Infosys, the Partner undertakes to return all materials to Infosys without any delay.
15. Each party shall ensure that they do not actively solicit the faculty of the other party who is involved in the implementation of this MOU during the period of such faculty's involvement with the program and for six (6) months thereafter.
16. Both the parties agree that Infosys is not obliged on account of this MOU to recruit any fixed number of students from the Partner.
17. This MOU is an indication of good faith and intent on the part of both parties and does not create any legal obligations between them. 18. Save and except for Clause 6, Clause 7 and Clause 8, this MOU is not a legally binding contract and under no circumstances does this MOU subject either of the parties to liability for breach, whether material or minor, of contract or any other liability under international law or the laws of the country of the respective parties or any other applicable law.





### MUTUAL NON-DISCLOSURE AND CONFIDENTIALITY AGREEMENT

This is an **agreement** ("Agreement" hereafter) between:

The parties possess competitively valuable Confidential Information (as hereinafter defined) regarding their past, current and future services and products, research and development, customers, business plans, software, listings, holdings, alliances, investments, transactions, intellectual property and rights associated thereto and general business operations. The parties wish to enter into a mutually beneficial relationship, and as such, wish to share their Confidential Information with the other party, including its authorized employees and agents. For the purposes of this Agreement, the party that discloses Confidential Information to the other party shall be referred to as the "Disclosing Party", and the party that receives such Confidential Information from the other party shall be referred to as the "Recipient".

The Recipient may be given access to the Disclosing Party's Confidential Information or to create new Confidential Information for the Disclosing Party.

In view of the above, the parties agree as follows:

#### 1. Confidential Information

"Confidential Information" includes any information:

- specifically indicated by the Disclosing Party, either verbally or in writing, as confidential;
- under the circumstances of the disclosure, that are to be treated as confidential; or
- the Recipient creates or produces while performing its obligations under this Agreement, regardless of the media that contains the information.

Confidential Information does not include information, which:

- is generally available to the public at the time of its disclosure to the Recipient;



- becomes known to the public through no fault/action of the Recipient in violation of the terms herein;
- is legally known to the Recipient at the time of disclosure by the Disclosing Party;
- is furnished by the Disclosing Party to third parties without restriction; or
- is furnished to the Recipient by a third party who to the Recipient's knowledge legally obtained said information and the right to its disclosure.
- is developed independently by Recipient without use of or reference to the Disclosing Party's information.

## 2. Restrictions on Use

- (a) The Recipient will not disclose any Confidential Information to third parties for any purpose without the prior written consent of the Disclosing Party. However, where the Recipient is required to disclose Confidential Information in accordance with judicial or other governmental action, the Recipient will give the Disclosing Party reasonable prior notice unless such notice is prohibited by applicable law.
- (b) The Recipient will not use any Confidential Information for any purposes except those expressly contemplated or authorized by the Disclosing Party.
- (c) The Recipient will take the same reasonable security precautions as it takes to safeguard its own confidential information, but in no case less than reasonable care.
- (d) The Recipient undertakes to impose the confidentiality obligations on all directors, officers and employees or other persons who work for the Recipient or under its direction and control, and who will have access to the Confidential Information.
- (e) The Recipient will return all originals, copies, reproductions and summaries of Confidential Information in its control, or confirm its destruction as requested by the Disclosing Party.

## 3. Action on Breach

- (a) The Recipient will notify the Disclosing Party immediately upon discovery of any breach of this Agreement by the Recipient, and will cooperate in every reasonable way to help the Disclosing Party regain possession of the Confidential Information and prevent further breach.
- (b) The Disclosing Party will be entitled, without waiving any other rights or remedies, to seek such injunctive or equitable relief as may be deemed proper by a court of competent jurisdiction.



#### 4. Ownership and Warranties

- (a) All Confidential Information, including the inherent intellectual properties, remains the sole and exclusive property of the Disclosing Party and the Recipient shall have no right, title or interest in the same. Similarly, the Disclosing Party does not own any of the intellectual property of the Recipient, including any proprietary methodologies, tools or practices, unless otherwise agreed.
- (b) The Disclosing Party, unless expressly confirmed, makes no warranty regarding the accuracy or reliability of Confidential Information.

#### 5. Applicability of Provisions

- (a) The provisions of this Agreement are jointly and severally applicable and will not be considered waived by any act or acquiescence, except by a specific prior written confirmation. Accordingly, both parties will expressly agree in writing to any changes in the Agreement.
- (b) If any provision of this Agreement is held illegal, invalid or unenforceable by law, the remaining provisions will remain in effect. Moreover, should any of the obligations of this Agreement be found illegal or unenforceable for any reasons, such obligations will be deemed to be reduced to the maximum duration, scope or subject matter allowed by law.
- (c) If any action at law or in equity is necessary to enforce or interpret the rights arising out of or relating to this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover reasonable attorney's fees, costs and necessary disbursements in addition to any other relief to which it may be entitled.

#### 6. Jurisdiction

This Agreement will be governed by the laws of India on all substantive aspects, and both parties consent to the jurisdiction of the courts in Bangalore.

#### 7. Tenure and Survival

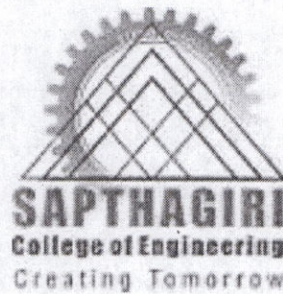

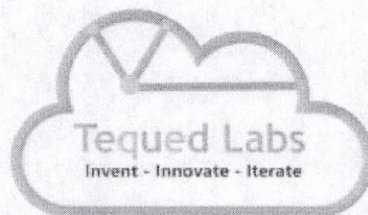

In the event, the parties are unable to do so, the matter will be settled by arbitration subject to the provision of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and as amended from time to time. The Parties agree shall mutually endeavor to appoint a single arbitrator, within a period of thirty (30) days upon being called upon to do so. In the event, the Parties fail to appoint a single arbitrator, by mutual agreement, each Party will appoint one arbitrator and the two arbitrators so appointed



will appoint a third arbitrator to whom the dispute will be referred for resolution. The arbitration proceedings shall be in English and held in Bangalore and in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 and as amended from time to time.

**11. Governing Law and Jurisdiction.**

11.1 This MoU shall be governed by the laws of Republic of India. Any dispute arising in connection therewith shall be submitted only to the Courts in Bangalore, India.

10. The terms and conditions mentioned herein shall commence on the execution of this MOU and shall continue for a period of two (2) years from the date thereof or for such period as




