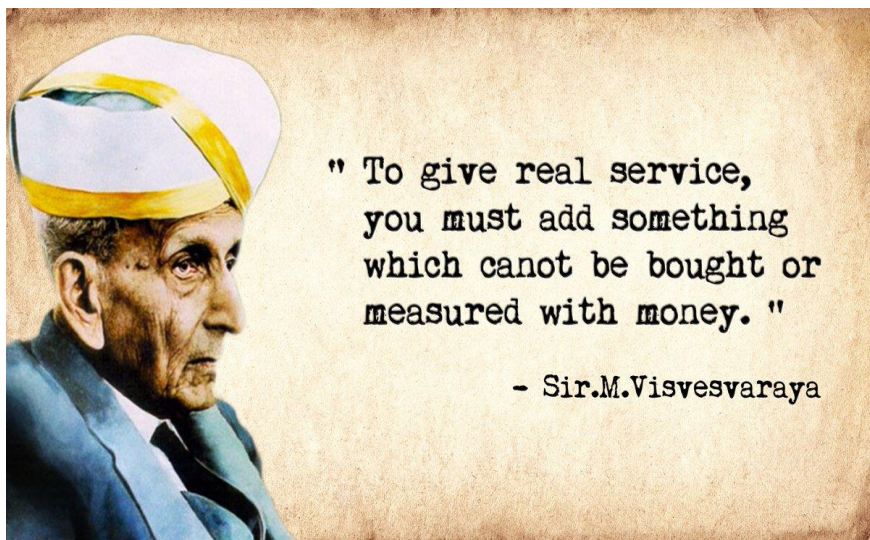
## HOD's Desk

## You are beautiful and you deserve to walk

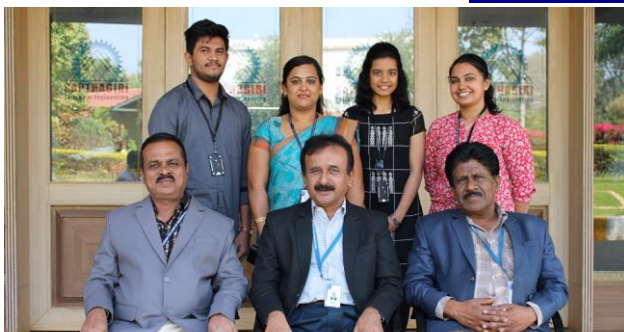
Let go of the crutches
